The Society PayPal Account

If you wish to use this facility you must have an existing account with PayPal, or set up an account with them. This is a simple procedure: visit their website at www.paypal.com. Members can use this service to pay for any of the Society's goods or services (Membership, subscriptions, visits, sales, etc). Payments can be funded either directly from bank accounts or through credit cards registered with PayPal.

To make a payment simply log-on to your account and select SEND MONEY. In the first box please enter our PayPal e-mail address, which is **ricardianfunds@yahoo.co.uk**, and indicate whether the payment is for services/other or goods. Enter the amount (always the pounds sterling amount minus the £ sign) and specify currency as GBP sterling.

We have to pass on a 5% surcharge for this service, and this should be added to the grand total (order plus postage). For example, an order totals £14.00 including the relevant postage and packing. Adding the 5% surcharge (£0.70) will bring the final total to £14.70. Please note for sales the surcharge is on the total order, not per item.
